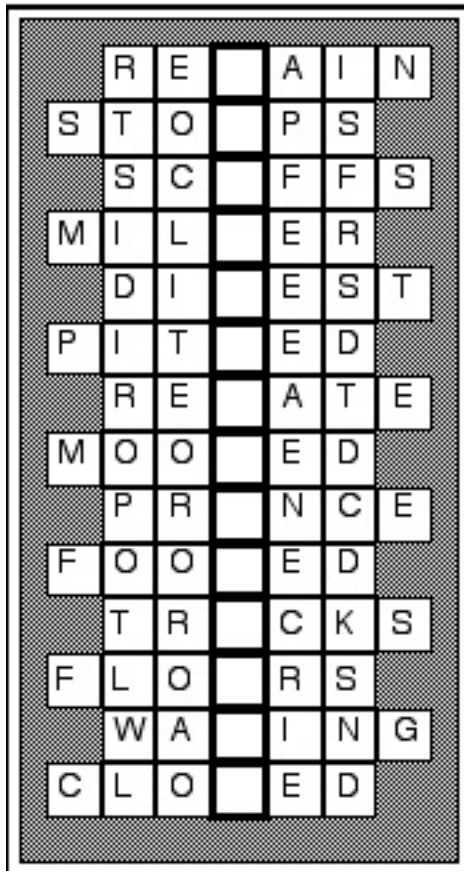


Choicewords – from Classic Rock!

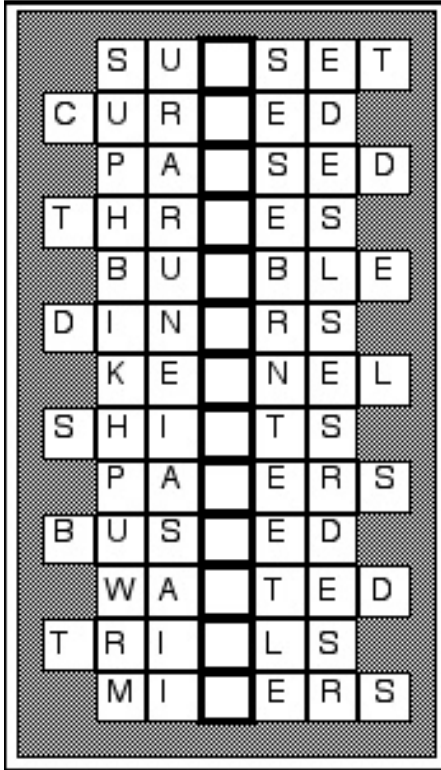
Buzzes at the Beach?
